Many villages in Papua New Guinea are isolated by rugged terrain and struggling with little hope of hearing God's Word.

In these isolated communities, there is very little, if any infrastructure and people survive on what they can grow or kill to eat.

It is an oral society with many different tribal languages. Tok pisin can be used in many areas to bring Christ's message of hope to people without reading skills...



With the use of small rugged solar powered mp3 players, loaded with a tok pisin bible, or children's stories about Jesus. This small machine will be listened to for hours at a time, reaching the hearts of many who have never before heard God's WORD.



Or maybe a handcranked/solar operated machine, such as the 'proclaimer' can be used, loaded with teaching material for the use of pastors and church workers.

This may be used as an 'assistant teacher' to a local Bible School teacher, Sunday School teacher, home fellowship Bible study etc.



For pastors, teachers and church workers with reading skills and access to the internet via their CRMF HF radio, they can learn via distance learning. This is in conjunction with existing Bible Colleges in PNG.

For example CRMF is in the process of installing a HF radio at Christian Leaders Training College (CLTC), so students can keep in touch with tutors at the college.



In a land where most rural Pastors have no formal training and discipleship of Christians in many areas is non-existent, these resources are invaluable.

With YOUR help, many people will hear God's Word for the first time. Many more will be able to receive discipleship training and learn how to live in a way that will honour Christ.

Pastors will receive the help they need to equip and build up their flock.

#### Our Goals

- To train and equip local pastors
- To provide Scripture resources in audio format for oral societies
- To enable others to conduct in-service training for remote pastors
- To facilitate the translation of discipleship materials into Tok Pisin and then into audio format for oral learners
- To link pastors with local Bible Colleges to access resources for sermon preparation, teaching and training.

In partnership with organisations like the Bible Society of PNG, and CLTC we aim to assist, empower and equip people living in remote communities to grow in the knowledge of Jesus Christ and make a personal commitment that will last for eternity.
